The Authority's current three-year contract for annual cryogenic maintenance turnaround/emergency use Liquid Oxygen Supply expires on August 15, 2016.

The bidding procedure consisted of advertisement to bid posted for one week in the Daily Herald and the Village of Glen Ellyn website from Monday, June 6, thru Friday, June 10, 2016. Bid Opening at the Glenbard Wastewater Authority on Wednesday, June 15, 2016 at 9:00 AM.

The Authority received two bids, and a notice from a third bidder that they formally elected not to bid. Based on the two bids that were received the Authority would like to award Airgas LLC the Liquid Oxygen Supply contract for a unit cost price per 100 CCF based on the following three-year term beginning August 15, 2016.

- Year One - \$ 0.4140
- Year Two - \$ 0.4347
- Year Three - \$ 0.4565

#### 5.4 Engineering Shortlist Recommendation

After months of interviews the Authority along with the Public Works Directors from the member villages have decided that the recommendations below will improve the competitive nature of the engineering shortlist by removing firms that have either not been responsive, or have not been successful with fulfilling the expectations of the Authority.

The Authority recommends the following changes to the engineering shortlist.

Remove the following firms from the engineering shortlist:

1. HR Green
2. Walter E. Deuchler & Associates

Add the following firms to the engineering shortlist:

1. Donahue and Associates
2. Carollo Engineers

The Authority respectfully requests the approval of the EOC to proceed with the changes to the engineering shortlist as described above.

#### 5.5 IEPA SRF Loan Resolution #07-16

Based on GWA attorney Greg Dose's discussions with the IEPA Financial Section in-house attorney Vera Herst we will need to proceed with Authority and village approvals in much the same fashion as was done in 2007. Because GWA is not a stand-alone entity that sets rates, bills customers and collects revenue on its own, Ms. Herst wants to see an ordinance from each village that:

1. Approves the loan.
2. Commits to setting rates and making payments sufficient to cover its share of debt service.
3. Confirms that public notice of the opportunity for a referendum was given.
  - a. Only applies to Lombard, as it is a non-home rule municipality.

The low bid contractor Boller Construction has agreed to extend the bid until the middle of August. This provides Glen Ellyn and Lombard the opportunity to get the loan ordinances approved through the proper channels. This process has inadvertently provided us with more savings due to interest rates being reduced by the IEPA on the SRF Loan to 1.76% from 1.85%. This reduction in percentage equates to approximately \$190,000 in interest savings over the life of the loan.
